

## Synopsis Bagram Access Road

This solicitation is for a design-build contract to construct six (6) segments of road as described within this scope of work. This work includes, but is not limited to, the survey, design, and construction of a 7m-wide asphalt carriageway with 1.5m asphalt shoulders for approximately 20 Km of road in the vicinity of Bagram located in the Parwan Province of Afghanistan. The road shall be a "Major Road" as defined in the "Islamic Republic of Afghanistan Ministry of Public Works Interim Road and Highway Standards" dated 21 March 2005, and constructed consistent with industry practices and standards referenced in this document to include, but not be limited to, sub-grade preparation, sub-base and base course construction, prime and tack coats, Hot-Mix Asphalt (HMA) placement, drainage structures, shoulders, curbs and sidewalks, striping and traffic signs. The pavement section shall consist of the following materials and minimum thicknesses; HMA 100mm, Base Course 200mm, Sub-Base Course 200mm, and Scarify and Compacted In Place Sub-Grade 150mm. The contractor is to construct a perimeter road surrounding Bagram Air Field (BAF) by connecting road segments together. Road segments are described below; all coordinates are approximate locations.
