

The Afghanistan Engineer District North (AEN) of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is currently soliciting presentations from local IT/Wi-Fi Service Providers demonstrating how they can install, activate, operate and maintain Wi-Fi service for personnel at the Qalaa House compound. The presentations should address at a minimum the following factors:

1. Locations available to support equipment (roof tops, common closets)
2. Infrastructure support (conduit runs if required, wiring, etc.)
3. Power generation to support equipment (generators, A/C units, etc)
4. Security aspects of wireless signaling on the compound.
5. Signal interference from/to various electronic devices/systems on the compound
6. Access for technicians for maintenance and operability issues

The above factors are not all inclusive.
