Description

Description: This announcement is for the purpose of soliciting names of construction contractors interested in submitting an offer to provide construction services for the Afghan National Army (ANA) Gamberi Garrison Phase II site in Jalalabad, Nangarhar Province, Afghanistan. All contractors are invited to participate in this solicitation. Project Scope: Complete the Civil, Site, Architectural, Structural, Mechanical, and Electrical work requirements to design and construct Phase II facilities for the ANA Gamberi Garrison and infrastructure in Jalalabad, Nangarhar Province, Afghanistan. It is the Government's intent to provide the design for many of the facilities and leave some of the designs to be completed by the contractors' designer. Responsibility to identify these design and design details are that of the contractor and not the Government under the Design/Build concept. The Master Plan for the Phase II will be supplied by the Government. The contractor shall perform work that consists of topographic survey, grading, design and construction of new buildings, tie-in of new buildings to existing utilities, construction of solid waste transfer points, design and construct a paved road network inside of the compound, POV and military vehicle parking areas. The contractor shall perform a geotechnical investigation for the building foundations. These facilities shall be designed and construct in accordance with current American or European or other equivalent standards as determined by the Government, building codes, safety and security standards and applicable local requirements. The magnitude of this construction project is between \$ 25,000,000.00 and \$ 100,000,000.00 USD. The expected base contract duration is 300 days. The solicitation will not be provided to subcontractors, suppliers, or vendors. Contracting Procedures: The solicitation will be a request for proposal (RFP). Source selection will be made using the best value trade-off process. Both non-pricing (technical) and price proposals are required. The evaluation factors with their significance

and weight will be provided in the RFP. The Government may include options in the solicitation. The contract will be awarded on a firm-fixed price basis.

Acquisition Time Line: Tentative date for issuance of Request for Proposal (RFP) number W917PM-08-R-0042 is 17 May 2008 and will be posted on the AED Web Site listed below. Tentative date for receipt of proposals is 28 June 2008. USACE will conduct a pre-proposal conference in the Qalaa House DFAC on 25 May 2008 from 09:00-10:00.
