Project Scope: Construct bulk fuel storage and supply facilities to include storage tanks, pumping facilities and controls at the South Fuel Farm as part of the overall phased fuels construction program at Bagram Airfield, Afghanistan. The scope of work includes construction of one (1) 2.1 million gallon (50,000 BL) JP-8 storage tank, one (1) 2.1 million gallon (50,000 BL) TS-1 fuel storage tank, and two (2) 30K gallon mogas tanks for forward refueling purposes. The bulk fuel storage tanks will be cut and cover tanks. Supporting facilities include two (2) filter buildings, other aboveground storage tanks, vehicle fueling facilities, site work, mechanical, electrical, and communications work to produce a complete and useable facility. Note that there will be on-going construction work as part of the overall fuels construction program and portions of the fuels system will be in use by Bagram Airfield. The magnitude of this construction project is between \$25,000,000.00 and \$100,000,000.00 USD. The expected contract duration is three hundred sixty five (365) days. Plans and Specifications: Two (2) sets of the solicitation will be issued on compact disk (CD) to prime contractors at no cost. The solicitation will not be provided to subcontractors, suppliers, or vendors. Contracting Procedures: The solicitation will be a request for proposal (RFP). Source selection will be made using the best value trade-off process. Both non-pricing (technical) and price proposals are required. The evaluation factors with their significance and weight will be provided in the RFP. The Government may include options in the solicitation. The contract will be awarded on a firm-fixed price basis. Acquisition Time Line: Tentative date for issuance of Request for Proposal (RFP) number W912ER-08-R-0054 is 08 May 2008. Tentative date for receipt of proposals is 22 June 2008. A pre proposal conference/site will be tentatively scheduled for 26 May 2008. Tentative date to award the contract is 18 Jul 2008.
