The following have been added by full text:

Questions and Answers

Q1: Are electronic proposals accepted?

A1: Yes

Q2: Does the aircraft required need to be a combination of cargo/passenger?

A2: Yes

Q3: Optional Camera System

Q3A: Will the government provide the operator?

A3A: If it's a point and click system, the PRT manager or engineer could probably do it with a little training. If it's something complicated, then they'd probably have to provide the operator.

Q3B: Will it be operational on all missions?

A3B: No.

Q3C: Must it be operational at contract award?

A3A: No, but it should be available soon after awards (i.e. within 30 days).

Q4: Can further discussion take place after award to ensure an appropriate system is procured?

A4: Yes

Q5: When is the expected date of award and thus the beginning of the first period of performance?

A5: Period of performance is expected to begin on January 1, 2010.

Q6: It does not mention any requirement to have the aircraft under Air Operators certificate (AOC). Does the aircraft have to be under an AOC?

A7: Yes.

Q7: Is there any other documentation apart from the solicitation Pages 1 – 63?

A7: No.

Q8: What does LS and MO stand for on page 4 of the solicitation?

A8: LS = Lump Sum; MO = Month

Q9: What is the maximum payload capacity?

A9: No maximum capacity specified

Q10: Is the minimum payload capacity required for all destinations?

Q11: Regarding Section 2, par O of the BPA in lieu of a pressurized cabin, can passengers be fitted with a CAA approved supplemental oxygen system?

A11: No. The cabin must be pressurized.

Q12: Due to the unique requirements of this RFP, a purpose built aircraft will need to be mobilized into the AOR. Will mobilization costs be allocated?

A12: See updated Bid Schedule.

PROPOSAL SCHEDULE NOTES

1. Offeror shall submit prices on all items. The Government will evaluate the Contractor's entire proposal to determine the lowest price technically acceptable to the Government. The period of performance is for base year and the option for two additional one-year periods from the date of award.

2. One or more Agreements will be awarded under this solicitation. This project will be awarded as a firm fixed price contract. This Proposal Schedule is an accounting tool for allocating funds to applicable budget. All costs associated with this project (i.e. security, insurance, life support, etc.) shall be included in the line items in the bidding schedule.

3. ****Estimate Quantities.** For line items identified as estimate quantity line items, the maximum quantity is an estimated ceiling not to exceed amount, and the minimum quantity is the guaranteed minimum amount. The contract will only be paid for quantities actually utilized that exceed the minimum quantity. At no time will the contractor exceed the estimated quantity on any estimated quantity line item. The contractor will establish a tracking system of actual quantities against the contract's estimated quantities for each estimated quantity line item, and will maintain the tracking system up to date throughout the life of the contract. The contractor must receive a modification BEFORE proceeding with work over the existing estimated quantity. The modification will set the new estimated quantity that the contractor may not exceed without another modification. A full accounting of each estimated quantity line item billed, the actual quantity being billed, and full documentation to support the actual quantities will accompany every invoice.

4. ****Minimum Quantities.** The minimum quantity requested is a guaranteed minimum fixed quantity for that line item. The contractor will receive the minimum proposed bid at the performance period as long as they have met the performance requirements of the Agreement. All quantities over the minimum amount are estimate quantities*.
