**SUMMARY OF CHANGES**

The following have been added by full text:

1. Section 00113 is changed as follows:

The following sentence is hereby added at the end of paragraph 2.4 (SUBMITTAL FORMAT):

Proposal pages shall be numbered sequentially.

2. Section 01015 is changed as follows:

Paragraph 2.4.1.1e, delete in its entirety and replace with:

e. Hydro-pneumatic tanks - Volume and pressure regulation to maintain a pressure range provided in the technical requirements based on the capacity to provide a minimum water flow of 5.0 liters per second at a minimum pressure of 275 kPa."

Paragraph 2.4.1.2.9, delete in its entirety and replace with the following:

The Contractor shall provide horizontally mounted and insulated above ground hydro-pneumatic tank(s) containing water and compressed air located adjacent to the booster pumps to maintain system pressures between 275 kPa to 282 kPa. A compressor is required to charge the tank with air. At low level the water remaining in the tank shall be at least ten percent of the capacity of the tank. The tank size shall be determined such that the pump cycles not less than four (4) times per hour or more than ten (10) times per hour. Storage may be divided between duplicate units in cases where a single tank would be too long to easily transport to the site. The storage facility shall be located above drainage areas and locations subject to flooding as approved by the KO. The Contractor shall design the hydro-pneumatic tanks per the requirements of the AED Design Requirements-Hydro-Pneumatic Tanks.

3. Section 00010 (Proposal Schedule) is replaced in its entirety with the section 00010 attached on the following pages of this amendment.

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**PROPOSAL SCHEDULE NOTES**

1. Offeror shall submit prices on all items. Scope of work on each items are described in Section 01010. The quantities shown in the bid schedule shall take precedence and be used for developing the proposal.
2. Only one contract for the entire schedule will be awarded under this solicitation. This project will be awarded as a single contract. This Proposal Schedule is an accounting tool for allocating funds to applicable budget.
3. Costs associated with this project shall include design and construction costs, site development, and utility installation.
4. DESIGN COSTS DEFINITION: Design costs shall consist of design analysis, drawings, and specifications for all facilities.
5. The government has the right to reduce the number of units in a bid item or choose to delete a base bid item entirely if necessary after the proposals are received.
6. EVALUATION OF OPTIONS: The award will be made to the Offeror whose proposal represents the best overall value to the Government. For pricing purposes the Government will evaluate both the Base Proposals and Option Proposals. The Government is not obligated to exercise the options.
7. EXERCISE OF OPTIONAL BID ITEMS: Optional bid items may, at the option of the Government, be added to the contract at any time within 120 calendar days after receipt of the notice to proceed for Base Proposal.
8. ORDER of WORK: The following order of work shall apply before start of optional bid items: See Section 00150 for Order of Work.
9. PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES: See Section 00150 for performance schedule and liquidated damages. Period of performance is defined as the number of calendar days from receipt of notice to proceed. Liquidated damages are assessed at the stated rate per day for every day of delay past the period of performance until contract completion for either the Base Items or the Optional Items whichever is applicable.
