PROPOSAL SCHEDULE NOTES

1. **BID:** Offeror shall submit prices on all bid items. Scope of work on each items are described in Section 01010. The quantities shown in the bid schedule shall take precedence and be used for developing the proposal.
2. **AWARD:** Only one contract for the entire schedule will be awarded under this solicitation. This project will be awarded as a lump sum contract. This Proposal Schedule is an accounting tool for allocating funds to applicable budget.
3. **COSTS:** Costs associated with this project shall include design and construction costs, site development, and utility installation.
4. **DESIGN COSTS DEFINITION:** Design costs shall consist of design analysis, drawings, and specifications for all facilities.
5. **COST LIMITATION:** The established design cost limitation for all Design Costs, as defined in Paragraph 4, shall not exceed six (6) percent of the total construction cost.
6. **DELETION OF BID ITEMS:** The government has the right to reduce the number of units in a bid item or choose to delete a bid item entirely if necessary after the proposals are received.
7. **ORDER of WORK:** All base bid contract line items have equal priority.

8. PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES: See Section 00150 for performance schedule and liquidated damages. Period of performance is defined as the number of calendar days from receipt of notice to proceed. Liquidated damages are assessed at the stated rate per day for every day of delay past the period of performance until contract completion.

SECTION 00800 - SPECIAL CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS

The following have been added by full text:

Weesh Chaman Q&A 1

Q1. Reference to the drawing regarding 110 personnel Barracks with 579 GSM, 515.4 NSM for billeting, and 38.16 NSQ for storage will not be enough for 110 personnel, shall the design be modified to fulfill the requirements,

A1. Yes, please adjust the design if the discrepancies are significant.

Q2. A space of 704 SM (see drawings) for 10 female personnel seems to be larger than the actual requirements, shall the design be modified or no change is necessary

A2. On the BP Women Barrack sketch, the dimensions are given in FEET. So, it's 704 Square Feet, (not Square Meters).

Q3. The scope calls for Kiosks of 8.6 SM each at the ECP, but the drawing shows covered Canopy, shall we provide canopy at the inspection points and lanes

A3. Yes, a canopy is needed. This area is of a very similar design with a Highway Toll Plaza.

Q4. The location of sliding and drop arm gates are not indicated in the drawings, shall we provide steel sliding/swing and arm gates across all lanes

A4. Yes, both drop arms and swing/sliding gates are needed just pass the kiosks.

Q5. Please refer proposal schedule items 004f and 004g regarding (Water Treatment and Storage Facility) & (Well House and Water Treatment Plant) respectively. These two items are almost identical and duplicated. In our interpretation item 004g; "Well House and Water Treatment Plant" will serve the purpose for water treatment. Could you please make verification about the issue?

A5. Item 004g should only say "Well House" – this item shall apply to just the construction of the well house building under a separate bid item. The actual well, pumps, etc., shall be included in Item 004f along with the Water Treatment. See Corrected Bid Schedule reflecting this change.

Q6. Refer to the subject RFP for Weish Chama Border Control Crossing the last date given for Past Performance Questionnaire Submission is March 02, 2011 at page 15, of the RFP (attached) where as the RFP is released on March 07, 2011. Therefore, please confirm what the last for submission of Past Performance Questionnaire is.

A6. This is an error in the RFP. The Past Performance Questionnaires are due NLT the Closing Time/Date of the RFP.

Q7. Please provide site plans indicating the aggregate and concrete roads and pedestrian walkways. For example; There is no road shown on A01 drawing to TP-3 and IG-1/2 buildings.

A7. There is no need for that as the ENTIRE compound area around the Transloading Dock and the Warehouses shall be made for vehicular traffic.

- a) **As a rule, wherever roads are left undefined inside a fenced compound, the intention is for the entire area to be made for traffic. Otherwise, the contractor shall design the vehicular traffic reasonably close to the wadi, to the fence and to the perimeter wall as to allow for ample space to maneuver. Within such an area sidewalks MAY not be needed. This includes the utility traffic for the WT and the DFAC, and the Outbound and Inbound Cart & Pedestrian Traffic.**
- b) **Building C-1 is contained inside an almost continuous double line – this is intended to represent a AT concrete barrier. The area contained by the barrier around building C-1 is a pedestrian sidewalk.**
- c) **Aside of what is being suggested by the government, the contractor may use his experience and should propose alternate vehicular and sidewalk designs that may be more economical, but that will still satisfy the functional needs of the facility.**
- d) **Sidewalks are specifically shown at the 3 barracks compounds, but there too, the contractor may suggest alternate designs for economical and functional reasons.**

Q8. Regarding the past experience factor of the evaluation, one of the requirements in this factor is to demonstrate a project been performed in Afghanistan. Will the submittal of a nominated sub-contractor past experience with more than 20% works to be performed satisfy the requirement of (a project been performed in Afghanistan)? We are willing to use our nominated sub-contractor past experience as a prime contractor to satisfy this requirement. Other requirements are met by the prime contractor. Please advice.

A8. No. Per Section 00113, Technical Experience Factor 4.1.1.1: "...forms shall be used to provide descriptions of projects which show PRIME CONTRACTOR experience with the features/ activities delineated in paragraph 4.1.1.2. Experience as a Sub-Contractor will not be considered as meeting the above requirement for Experience."
