**SUMMARY OF CHANGES**

The following have been added by full text:

The purpose of W5J9LE-11-R-0031 Amendment 0001 is to answer questions from Industry, received in response to the initial solicitation posting, replace Form A1 and Form A2, replace Section 00010, and correct minor typographical errors. The proposal due date is NOT extended as a result of Amendment 0001.

Q.1. Could you please advise for which project a proposal is requested? Is the purpose of this solicitation to collect proposals for the general requirement described as "The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Afghanistan District South intends to issue a Firm-Fixed Price, Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) Multiple Award Task Order Contract (MATOC) for Construction and Design-Build Construction Services in support of Afghan National Security Forces (AFNS) facilities requirements in southern and western Afghanistan. This solicitation will result in a MATOC for five (5) years total, with a two (2) 24 month base year with three (1) one year options."? Or is it specifically for the project "AFGHANISTAN NATIONAL ARMY, 215th MI/MP/Courthouse at Camp Shorab, Helmand Province, Afghanistan"?

A.1. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Afghanistan District South intends to issue a Firm-Fixed Price, Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) Multiple Award Task Order Contract (MATOC) for Construction and Design-Build Construction Services in support of Afghan National Security Forces (ANSF) facilities requirements in southern and western Afghanistan. This solicitation will result in a MATOC for five (5) years total, with a two (2) year base period (not-to-exceed (NTE) 24 months) and three (3) one-year option periods (NTE 12 months each). Along with the MATOC, the Government intends to award the Seed Task Order, Afghanistan National Army, 215th MI/MP/Courthouse at Camp Shorab, Helmand Province, Afghanistan, as Task Order 0001.

The proposals will be evaluated on six (6) evaluation Factors. The non-price factors are weighted as follows: In determining the overall best value, Technical is the most important factor. The Technical Factor rating shall be a roll-up of Factors 1, 2, 3 and 4 (Experience, Resources, Management Approach and Security Plan). The overall Technical Factor rating is more important than Factor 5 (Past Performance) and when taken together, the non-price factors are significantly more important than Factor 6, Price. The Price factor will evaluate the Offeror's proposal for the Seed Task Order.

Q.2. It says in the RFP Memo for this project that a site visit is scheduled for this project, but I do not see Section 01901 anywhere in the solicitation. According to RFP Memo dated 19 May 2011, paragraph C, it states that there is a formal site visit for this project. However, we could not find any further reference as to the date and time for the site visit. Can you please let me know when that site visit will take place? Attachment 1 dated 19 May 2011, Item e. Site Visit states "A formal site visit is scheduled for this project..." Can you please tell us when this formal site visit will be schedule for? "A Formal site visit is scheduled for this project (Solicitation: W5J9LE-11-R-0031) and for more information refer to FAR Clause 52.236.-27 in section 01901". We searched for that Clause, but unfortunately clause 52.236-27 is missed from the section. It is you're kindly, if you notify XXXXX Company about the formal Site visit of the above project.

A.2. There will not be a site visit for this project.

Q.3. Please amend 0003D and 0003D (Officer Barracks and Small Officer Barracks) in the proposal schedule.

A.3. CLIN 0003 numbering corrected. See Section 00010 – Amendment 0001, included herein.

Q.4. Please confirm the gross area of courthouse Building. The scope calls for a two story building with a total gross area of 640sm (first floor and second floor), while your drawing in appendix part 1 the area of the courthouse building is 1019.9sm for both floors.

A.4. The total gross area is 696 SM (square meters), not 640. The 640 is a typographical error.

Q.5.a. **FACTOR 1 – EXPERIENCE:** Please provide the minimum threshold for the contract dollar value for the mentioned 7 experience projects.

A.5.a. See Page 18 of 118, Paragraph "MINIMUM THRESHOLD" and "AREAS OF INTEREST" and Page 19 of 118 Paragraph C.

Q.5.b. **FACTOR 1 – EXPERIENCE:** Please provide the minimum requirement for previous experience projects' percentage of completion at the time of solicitation.

A.5.b. See Page 18 Paragraph "FACTOR 1-EXPERIENCE and "MINIMUM THRESHOLD".

Q.5.c. **FACTOR 1 - EXPERIENCE:** Please provide if the previous experience projects shall be completed inside Afghanistan or not.

A.5.c. See Page 19 of 118, Third Line.

Q.5.d. **FACTOR 2 – RESOURCES, SUBFACTOR 1 PROGRAM EXECUTIVE TEAM:** Please provide information that which personnel resumes shall be included in the bidder's proposal.

A.5.d. See Page 13, Paragraph 3.

Q.6. Would you please tell me if the above-referenced solicitation is anticipating that the steel coils for K-Span construction will be GFM?

Q.6. The Government is not furnishing steel coils as GFM for the Seed Task Order.

Q.7. Since there is substantial reference to hard copy packaging, please confirm that electronic proposal submissions are acceptable and, therefore, hardcopies and CDs are not required?

A.7. Electronic submissions are acceptable and PREFERRED. Please see Section 00100 – Instructions to Offerors, numbers 1. g. and 4.

Q.8. Volume 1 Factor 5 contains two paragraphs labeled as number 1.

A.8. **FACTOR 5 - PAST PERFORMANCE** is re-numbered as shown:

***Submission Requirements:***

1. Letters, Certificates, Commendations and Awards

Provide, if available, evidence of quality work such as letters, certificates, commendations and awards. Documentation provided must be for the projects listed on Form A1 and should be placed immediately behind Form A2.

2. Form A2

Ensure there is sufficient contact information provided on Form A2 in order for the Government to verify past performance. Fully explain problem resolution and contract time extensions.

3. Government Availability of Existing Past Performance

a. The Corps of Engineers maintains an electronic database containing final evaluations of contract work known as "Construction Contractor Appraisal Support System (CCASS)". CCASS information has now been

placed in a data bank for all of Department of Defense known as “Past Performance Information Retrieval System (PPIRS)”. Government agencies, including the US Army Corps of Engineers, have access to the PPIRS and it is the Department of Defense preferred method to gather past performance data for Offerors seeking to do business with the Government. The Past performance data remains in the PPIRS up to six (6) years from contract completion date. If available, the PPIRS information will only be used for work performed within the last five (5) years.

b. Offerors are reminded that the Government reserves the right to obtain past performance information from any source available, and has the right to contact customers other than those listed by the Offeror to evaluate past performance.

**With respect to Joint Ventures, the proposal may receive a higher rating if the proposal contains evidence of the Joint Venture Entity working successfully together previously on relevant projects.**

Q.9. Form A2 is requested under one of these paragraphs in Factor 5 as well as in Factor 1. Furthermore, no reference sheet is provided in Factor 5. Should Form A2 be submitted under Factor 1 or Factor 5 and is there a reference sheet that needs to be completed under Factor 5?

A.9. See REVISED Form A2, attached herein. Form A2 should be submitted as part of Factor 1. The Government will utilize Form A2 to evaluate Factor 5 as well. The contractor does not need to submit duplicate copies of Form A2.

Q.10. Should resumes that are requested under Factor 2 for the PET include task order level key personnel referenced under Factor 3, including Project Manager, Designers, Safety and Quality Control Personnel, and Site Superintendents?

A.10. Factor 2 - Resources, Sub-factor 1 – Program Executive Team (PET), Paragraph 1, resumes are required for the PET team only.

Q.11. Factor 1 No. 2 states "Refer to paragraph III.2.b (page 7)", yet this reference could not be identified on page 7 of the RFP. Please verify the location of this paragraph.

A.11. Corrected to read, “Refer to Section 00100, Instructions to Offerors, Paragraph 2.b. (Page 9).”

Q.12. The SF 1442 indicates that Payment and Performance Bonds are not required. **Para 1.20 Bonding Requirements** in the Special Contract Requirements (page 105 of 118 of the RFP) indicates that the Contracting Officer is to determine if performance and payment bonds are required at the task-order level, and references 100% Payment and Performance Bonding Levels and providing a bond to cover the minimum guaranteed amount for the contract which will be increased to the value of a Task Order once awarded. Please confirm that Payment and Performance Bonds are not required, and 1.20 of Special Contract Requirements can be eliminated.

A.12. There is no Payment and Performance Bond requirement for Basic MATOC, nor for the Seed Task Order. Paragraph number 1.20 BONDING REQUIREMENTS, is hereby deleted from the Basic MATOC.

Q.13. Section 00100, “Bidding Schedule/Instructions to Bidders”, “Basic Proposal Submission Requirements” item 3, “Key Subcontractors” indicates that a letter of commitment signed by the key subcontractor and the prime contractor must be submitted and included as part of as part of Volume I. Please confirm that these letter(s) of commitment are to be included in Factor 1, “Experience”, and are not included in the page limitation.

A.13. The Letter of Commitment signed by the key subcontractor(s) and prime will be included in Factor 1 and **IS** included in the page limitation.

Q.14. Section 00100, "Bidding Schedule/Instructions to Bidders", "Basic Proposal Submission Requirements" item 5, "Proposal Format", "Factor 1 – Experience", "Submission Requirements", item 1.b states "Also provide an Experience Information Fact Sheet, Form A2, for each project listed on Form A1 Experience Overview Sheet." However, "Factor 5 - Past Performance", "Submission Requirements", item 1, "Form A2" states "Ensure there is sufficient contact information provided on Form A2 in order for the Government to verify past performance." Please confirm that Forms A2 are to be included only within Factor 1.

A.14. Contact information provided on REVISED Form A2 may be used in evaluating Factor 5 – Past Performance. Please see Factor 5 – Past Performance *evaluation criteria*, and paragraph number 5.

Q.15. Section 00100, "Bidding Schedule/Instructions to Bidders", "Basic Proposal Submission Requirements" item 5, "Proposal Format", "Factor 3-Management Approach" item 1 states "Only a single organizational chart, comprehensive for the entire contract, shall be submitted." However, Sub-factor 1 - Program Executive Team and the Evaluation Factors for Award for Sub-factor 2 – Resource Planning appears to require organizational charts for the Program Executive Team and the Seed Project, respectively. Are three organizational charts to be included with our proposal or is the single organizational chart, comprehensive for the entire contract to be included in Factor 3-Management Approach sufficient?

A.15. The following sentence is deleted in its entirety, "Only a single organizational chart, comprehensive for the entire contract, shall be submitted."

To further clarify, the Government requires an organizational chart for the Program Executive Team and the Seed Project only.

Q.16. Section 00100, "Bidding Schedule/Instructions to Bidders", "Basic Proposal Submission Requirements" item 5, "Proposal Format", "Factor 5 - Past Performance", "Submission Requirements", item 1, "Form A2" states "Ensure there is sufficient contact information provided on Form A2 in order for the Government to verify past performance." There does not appear to be any location to include contact information on Form A2. Please clarify.

A.16. See REVISED Form A2, attached herein.

Q.17. Question – Section 00100, "Bidding Schedule/Instructions to Bidders", "Basic Proposal Submission Requirements" item 5, "Proposal Format", "Factor 5 - Past Performance" states "Provide, if available, evidence of quality work such as letters, certificates, commendations and awards." Please confirm that these documents are excluded from the page count.

A.17. Evidence of quality work such as letters, certificates, commendations and awards **ARE** included in the page count.

Q.18. Question – Section 00100, "Bidding Schedule/Instructions to Bidders", "Basic Proposal Submission Requirements" item 5, "Proposal Format", "Factor 5 - Past Performance" item 1, "Form A2" states "Ensure there is sufficient contact information provided on Form A2 in order for the Government to verify past performance. Fully explain problem resolution and contract time extensions." Form A2, included as Appendix B on pages 32 and 33 only includes the requirement to identify The location work was performed, The day, month, and year work was completed, The final cost of this project, and indication if this project more than 50% complete and what role the Offeror played in the project. There does not seem to be a requirement for description of the project, cost or schedule adherence or quality. Additionally, the Evaluation Factors for Award includes six factors that do not appear to be included in Form A2. Will USACE be updating Form A2 to include this additional information?

A.18. See REVISED Form A1 and REVISED Form A2, attached herein.

Q.19. Section 00100, "Bidding Schedule/Instructions to Bidders", "Evaluation Factors for Award", "Factor 1- Experience" states "The Offeror will be evaluated on the relevancy of the experience demonstrated in the submitted EXPERIENCE OVERVIEW SHEET, Form A1, and EXPERIENCE INFORMATION FACT SHEET, Form A2." However, neither of these forms appears to include information required to receive additional weight for this factor in Section B:

- projects demonstrating the Offeror's ability to manage multiple projects simultaneously
- projects performed for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers;
- projects which demonstrate the Offeror's experience with the construction of facilities utilizing a significant amount of K-Span

Nor do they contain the following requirements identified in Section D:

- description of the project involved;
- description of the work actually performed by an Offeror or its subcontractor(s);

Nor do they contain the following requirements identified in Section E:

- Contact information should be provided for customer or client personnel

Will USACE be expanding Form A2 to include the desired information and format?

A.19. See REVISED Form A1 and REVISED Form A2 included herein.

Q.20. Section 00100, "Bidding Schedule/Instructions to Bidders", "Evaluation Factors for Award" item 4, "Basis for Award", "Factor 3: Management Approach" states "For this factor the Offeror must submit a management approach for successful execution of the contract and a graphical and narrative description of its planned organization structure, specific to the Seed Task Order" but item 4 indicates our Management Approach should illustrate "A reasonable approach to distribution of performance and resources (personnel) required to manage an annual workload for multiple task orders (of a value between \$5M and \$50M) awarded simultaneously at different locations, including a surge plan to manage projects if the maximum contract amount is issued in a one year period." Is this Management Approach to be tailored to the Seed Task Order as indicated or expanded to provide and overall Management Approach to the MATOC?

A.20. The following sentence, "**Evaluation Criteria:** For this factor the Offeror must submit a management approach for successful execution of the contract and a graphical and narrative description of its planned organization structure, specific to the Seed Task Order." is revised to read, "**Evaluation Criteria:** For this factor the Offeror must submit a management approach, and also a graphical and narrative description of its planned organization structure for successful execution of both the Basic MATOC contract and the Seed Task Order."

The following sentences are deleted in their entirety, "Proposals will be evaluated on this factor using the Seed Task Order as an example. Further the Offeror's graphical and narrative description of its planned organization structure, specific to the Seed Task Order will be evaluated."

The following sentence, "The Offeror's Management Approach should illustrate the following:" is revised to read, "The Offeror should illustrate the following:"

The following six (6) numbered items are applicable to either the Basic MATOC or both the Basic MATOC and the Seed Task Order as identified below, and shall be addressed accordingly:

1. (Basic MATOC and Seed Task Order) Clearly delineated lines of authority on the organizational chart (wire diagram or graph) organized in a precise and logical manner including the relationship between the headquarters' office and the site office, including all involved with the management of the contract including Key Subcontractors and Joint Venture partners.

2. (Basic MATOC and Seed Task Order) The graph and the narrative description clearly display the planned organization structure, including the Program/Project Manager and the logical distribution of Program Executive Team.

3. (Basic MATOC and Seed Task Order) Comprehensive descriptions of duties, roles, major responsibilities for Key Subcontractors and joint ventures presented as a logical approach to perform the work throughout the contract, including which roles and personnel are identified to communicate with the Government.
4. (Basic MATOC and Seed Task Order) A precise explanation illustrating an understanding of the contract requirements by describing management for performing a task order, including start-up/mobilization and additional and/or unique management advantages provided to the Government.
5. (Basic MATOC) A reasonable approach to distribution of performance and resources (personnel) required to manage an annual workload for multiple task orders (of a value between \$5M and \$50M) awarded simultaneously at different locations, including a surge plan to manage projects if the maximum contract amount is issued in a one year period.

6. (Basic MATOC) In keeping with the COIN Strategy of growing the economic capacity of Afghan through developing host nation businesses, it is incumbent upon Offerors to make every effort and to develop education programs and business solutions that foster economic growth. The Government seeks a contractor demonstrating the capability and commitment to use local labor, subcontractors, and suppliers in the performance of this project.

Q.21. Section 00700, "Contract Clauses", includes 52.236-25, "Requirements for Registration of Designers JUN 2003". Since this work is to be executed in Afghanistan, is it correct that US Professional Engineering Registration is not required for design deliverables and this clause will be deleted?

A.21. Section 00700, "Contract Clauses", includes 52.236-25, "Requirements for Registration of Designers JUN 2003". This clause is hereby deleted.

Q.22. Section 00555, "Design Concept Documents", paragraph 1.1, "Engineering And Design Criteria" states "The Specifications Divisions 02 thru 16 is the primary specifications criteria for the design and construction of the project." We could not locate Specifications Divisions 02 thru 16 in the Solicitation package. Please provide.

A.22. The Contractor shall develop the technical specifications based upon the UFGS Divisions 02 thru 16. All specifications can be found at [http://www.wbdg.org/ccb/browse\\_org.php?o=70](http://www.wbdg.org/ccb/browse_org.php?o=70).

Q.23. Question – Section 00555, "Design Concept Documents", paragraph 1.3, "Specifications" states "The Government will provide Division 1 specifications sections as required, to the successful Offeror; and these sections shall be included in the final construction specifications without change." USACE is requested to provide any additional specifications that will be required such that we can factor that into our proposal cost estimate.

A.23. The Division 1 specifications have been provided to the Contractor as part of the RFP all technical specifications other than Division 1 shall be provided by the Contractor.

Q.24. Section 01010, "Scope of Work", paragraph 4.3.1, "General Requirements for Facilities" states "The construction of the Standard Building Designs and Non-Standard Building Designs listed below shall be done in strict accordance with the plans furnished, with no changes made to any feature of work shown in these design drawings, unless otherwise specified." This section includes a list of three Standard Building Designs but does not indicate any "Non-Standard Building Designs". Please provide the Non-Standard Building Designs.

A.24. Change "Non-Standard Building Designs" to "Standard Non-Building Designs". All Standard Non-Building Designs are provided in the Appendix of the RFP.

Q.25. Section 01060, "Special Clauses", paragraph 1.4, "Responsibility for Physical Security" states "The Contractor shall be responsible for physical security of all materials, supplies, and equipment of every description, including property which may be Government-furnished or owned, for all areas occupied jointly by the Contractor and the Government, as well as for all work performed." How does the Government intend to address the risk resulting from unforeseen issues that arise from acts of war? Please confirm the Government will bear the risk and will equitably adjust the contractor for both cost and time under the Changes clause for such loss, damage or destruction of: (1) completed or partially completed work performed under this contract, (2) material, equipment, and/or installations, which are being used or were acquired for use, by the Contractor in the performance of this contract.

A.25. Per resultant contract terms and conditions, the Contractor shall be responsible for physical security of all materials, supplies, and equipment of every description, including property which may be Government-furnished or owned, for all areas occupied jointly by the Contractor and the Government, as well as for all work performed.

Q.26. Section 01335, "Submittal Procedures for Design-Build Project", paragraph 1.2.1.1, "Preliminary Design Reports – (10%)" states "The review of this submittal is primarily to ensure that the Contractor has at a minimum developed the test well and completed the sub-surface investigation." What test well is to be developed?

A.26. No well test is required. Any reference to well testing is hereby deleted.

Q.27. Section 01335, "Submittal Procedures for Design-Build Project", paragraph 3.6, "Submittal Procedure" as written (including size, number of copies, etc.) implies use of paper submittals. Due to the remote areas of work and requirements for timeliness, is it fair to assume that hard copies can be provided to the assigned USACE site engineer or, in his absence, that electronic submittal and approvals can be used for this Project?

A.27. All submittals shall be provided in hard copy and electronic copy. All hard copy submittals shall be submitted to the appropriate Area/Resident Office and AES Engineering Branch at Kandahar Air Field. All hard copy submittals shall be received at the Area/Resident Office and AES Engineering Branch at the same time, and if not submitted at the same time, the Government 14 day review period will not start until both the Area/Resident Office and AES Engineering Branch have received the submittal.
