-- CHANGED RESPONSE DATE TO 21 MAY 2011 -- AFGHANISTAN ENGINEER DISTRICT SOUTH (AES) Firm Fixed Price Contract for Afghan National Army (ANA), 215 Brigade Garrison Phase I at Camp Garmsir, Helmand Province, Afghanistan

The project consists of site-adapt engineering and construction of the Afghanistan National Army 215TH Brigade Garrison Phase I at Camp Garmsir, Helmand Province, Afghanistan. The project is defined as the engineering, materials, labor, and equipment to site-adapt and construct buildings, roads, utilities, and other infrastructure for an end population of approximately 5500 personnel. The project includes a variety of buildings and facilities that shall be site-adapted and constructed using the K-Span or the CMU construction method based upon fully developed design drawings. Some facilities will be developed by the contractor. The contractor shall be responsible for providing final engineering drawings for site work, site features, facilities, utilities, and all related engineering. The Contractor may be required to coordinate the efforts required under this contract with at least one other contractor at the site. Such coordination requirements will be required as part of this contract. Work shall be engineered and constructed in accordance with the current International Building Code (IBC) and Life Safety Codes (NFPA-101) where referenced.

Disclaimer: The term K-Span refers to a proprietary rolled steel arch span type structural system. Whenever the term K-Span is used, it refers to a K-Span type system or its equivalent.

The Government intends to make one award as a result of this solicitation.

Award of a contract will be made to the responsible offeror who submits a proposal representing the best value to the Government. All responsible sources may submit a proposal, which shall be considered by AES. Offers will be evaluated using the best value, tradeoff process in accordance with the evaluation criteria stipulated in the solicitation. The applicable NAICS code is 236220 (\$33.5M small business size standard). The resulting contract is for 545 days. The magnitude of construction for this project is between \$100M - \$250M. Offerors are asked to submit their expression of interest on or before 21 May 2011, to the point-of-contact via email.
