

SYNOPSIS

PROJECT: Project No. CP11-022 –Design and Construction of two (2) Bridges (SBZ-1011 and SBZ-1018) located on Highway 1 in Zabul Province, Afghanistan

Transatlantic South Kandahar (TAS) has a required for the Design and Construction of two (2) Bridges (SBZ-1011 and SBZ-1018), Zabul Province, Afghanistan. The project consists of the survey, design, material, labor, and equipment required to demolish, repair and rebuild damaged portions of Bridge SBZ-1011, Bridge SBZ-1018, complete channel upgrades, and maintain bypass traffic during the construction. Concept plans will be provided for information only and the Contractor shall provide a complete design for all aspects of the project. All design parameters shall be in accordance with the concept plan and specifications. Precast concrete bridge girders are preferred for bridge girder repairs and replacement. The contractor shall set up the precast concrete plant operation at or near the rock quarry in Qalat, Zabul Province, Afghanistan.

Period of performance is 360 days from the Notice To Proceed (NTP).

The magnitude of construction is estimated between \$500,000.00 and \$1,000,000.00.

The Contractor may be required to coordinate the efforts required under this contract with at least one other contractor at the site. Such coordination is required as part of this contract. The coordination effort may be significant and may include such tasks as the exchange of information with other contractors such as design data, drawings, calculations, and technical information. Additionally, it may be necessary for the contractor to conduct meetings, hold teleconferences, and prepare the submittal of additional information to the Contracting Officer (KO) that demonstrates the coordination and integration of new work with existing and future work of other contractors. All coordination shall be in agreement with the KO and approved prior to the commencement of any work.

This is a Request for Proposal (RFP) solicitation. Award of a contract will be made to the Lowest Price Technically Acceptable Proposal. The applicable NAICS code is 237310. The solicitation will be unrestricted/full and open. The RFP proposal due date will be contained in the solicitation and any solicitation amendments that may be issued.
