USACE-AES Operations and Maintenance  
Kandahar Air Field, Afghanistan

This announcement is a Request for Information (RFI) only. The United States Army Corps of Engineers, Afghanistan Engineer District South (USACE-AES) is seeking preliminary marketing information from capable and reliable sources for Operations and Maintenance (O&M) at Kandahar Air Field (KAF), Afghanistan. No formal solicitation exists at this time, but one may be released at a later date depending on the responses received from this sources sought notice. If a solicitation is released at a later date, a Firm-Fixed-Price Blanket Purchase Agreement (BPA) is being considered. The Period of Performance will be for a twenty-four (24) month period. The proposed requirement is to award one or more BPAs to O&M Facility Maintenance offerors who demonstrate they are capable of providing Operations and Maintenance (O&M) for specified facilities and grounds as follows: Buildings 1(720E), 2(720F), 3(720G), 4(720H), 5(720I), 6(720K), 7(720J), 8(720L), 9(720M), 10(720N) on the USACE-AES compound with qualified and credentialed tradesmen. The O&M services shall include all of these disciplines of work: Heating Ventilation and Cooling (HVAC), Electrical, Carpentry, Plumbing, Locksmith and Grounds maintenance. The Contractor shall furnish all labor, materials and supervisory management required for the performance of the work. It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor that all personnel are capable of receiving the appropriate identification documents for access to required areas at their respective sites and appropriate security levels.

Interested offerors must submit a brief but complete Capabilities Statement that demonstrates the company's capabilities to perform O&M Facility Maintenance.

Respondents must demonstrate knowledge and expertise providing the services identified above in an OCONUS (Outside the Continental United States) theater. Responses must reference the request for information, and contain the respondents commercial and government entity (CAGE) code, if available. Please reference each response with the question numbers as follows: 1) Company name, company mailing address, point of contact, telephone number, e-mail address, and size of your organization (i.e. Large Business, Small Business) using as the basis for your response. 2) Provide a limited discussion of how your firm will provide O&M services in a contingency, i.e., within Southern Afghanistan. 3) Respondents shall provide a list of contracts with current references that can provide past performance information relative to quality of services provided to an agency within the Department of Defense (DOD), U.S. State Department or other U.S. Government agencies within Afghanistan. Include complete references, contract titles, and dollar values, points of contact, email addresses, and telephone numbers. 4) Provide a limited discussion of the company's ability to offer experience, trained, certified and licensed personnel capable of supporting this effort. 5) Provide your company's assessment as to how you would perform unscheduled maintenance service calls and do you provide a 24-hour emergency service? 6) How many Afghan Local National professionals does your company currently employ or have under subcontract? 7) How long has your company operated in Iraq/Afghanistan Theater of Operations? 8) Is your company a foreign-owned/foreign-controlled firm? 9) Provide a copy of your company's AISA license, as applicable.
