Traveling by Road:

Drive up to Camp Shorabak's main ECP south of Highway 1.

Sign in with ANA Gate Guards and call USACE POC Mr. Henry Egbuka for Pick up and escort to the site.

Flying to Bastion:

Coordinate arrival time and airline with USACE POC Mr. Henry Egbuka prior to departure. This will ensure that you are met and escorted. Try to limit the number of personnel arriving because vehicle space is limited.

Ensure that all identification documents (Afghan Tasakara or Passport, company ID card, government issued CAC card, Drivers' license etc.) are current. Must be original documents, and not photocopies.

A USACE staff member shall meet and pick up contractors at the air terminals of their respective of your carriers with prior coordination. Otherwise, call USACE POC for Pick up and Escort to the badging office for temporary access badges through the ECP (Friendship Gate) between Camp Leatherneck and Camp Shorabak.

Be prepared for lengthy (an hour or more) security screening which could include biometric screening for Afghans and Third Country Nationals (TCNs). Personal Electronic Devices will need to be declared and authorized by the badging office, otherwise they will be confiscated. It is badging's discretion to not allow PEDs at all. You may opt to temporarily store devices at the badging office (check with badging staff).

Following completion of site visit, all temporary badges shall be returned to the Badging office and contractors shall subsequently be dropped off at their respective flight terminals to catch their return flights.

Important Rules:

Electronic Equipment - Cell phones, two-way radios, cameras, computers, etc. are prohibited unless a "Personal Electronics Devices" clearance or approval is obtained.

It is preferable that requests for "Personal Electronics Devices" be submitted to USACE a week prior to the scheduled site visit date and shall contain, at the minimum, the following:

Name, Position, and Nationality of Requester

Type of electronic device, Serial number and included whether or not device has internet capabilities.

For cell phones and SIM Cards, include type, phone number, Sim Card number and IMEI number.

For those flying into Bastion, advance submission (a week prior to site visit) of personal information (Full Name, birth place, Age, taskara/passport number, social security number, Nationality etc.) shall be required to facilitate badging.

Each contractor shall be limited to a maximum of three personnel for the site visit as each USACE personnel is limited to escort six people at a time, and vehicle space is limited.

The following have been modified:
