IS CHANGED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:
 - (1) Performance bonds ([Standard Form 25](#)). The penal amount of performance bonds at the time of contract award shall be **30 percent** of the original contract price.
 - (2) Payment Bonds ([Standard Form 25A](#)). The penal amount of payment bonds at the time of contract award shall be **30 percent** of the original contract price.
 - (3) Additional bond protection.
 - (i) The Government may require additional performance and payment bond protection if the contract price is increased. The increase in protection generally will equal **30 percent** of the increase in contract price.
 - (ii) The Government may secure the additional protection by directing the Contractor to increase the penal amount of the existing bond or to obtain an additional bond.
 - (c) Furnishing executed bonds. The Contractor shall furnish all executed bonds, including any necessary reinsurance agreements, to the Contracting Officer, within the time period specified in the Bid Guarantee provision of the solicitation, or otherwise specified by the Contracting Officer, but in any event, before starting work.
 - (d) Surety or other security for bonds. The bonds shall be in the form of firm commitment, supported by corporate sureties whose names appear on the list contained in Treasury Department Circular 570, individual sureties, or by other acceptable security such as postal money order, certified check, cashier's check, irrevocable letter of credit, or, in accordance with Treasury Department regulations, certain
