Project Scope: Construct a Fuel Storage/Distribution facilities at FOB Sharana and Shank, Afghanistan. The project will be delivered using a design-build approach. The contractor will be required to perform geotechnical studies and develop the civil and final foundations designs. Concept design-build civil drawings and technical requirements will be provided. Primary facilities at Sharana include 1,890 m3l fuel storage tanks, 650m of underground POL pipeline, and a 350 m2 fueling/POL support building. Also included are fueling pumps, fuel truck loading facility and building information systems. Primary facilities for Shank Phase 1 will include 1,153 m3l fuel storage tanks, with approximately 3,048m of underground POL pipeline and building information systems. Primary facilities for Shank Phase 2 will include 1,495 m3l fuel storage tanks, with approximately 808m of underground POL pipeline, and a 350 m2 fueling/POL support building. Also included are fueling pumps, fuel truck loading facility and building information systems. Supporting facilities for all three projects include electric service, water, sewer, gas, paving, walks, curbs and gutters, storm drainage, site improvements and / or demolition, information systems and other ancillary antiterrorism measures.

The magnitude of this construction project is between \$25,000,000.00 and \$100,000,000.00 USD. The expected contract duration is five hundred forty (540) days.

Plans and Specifications: Will be provided via electronic means. The specifications will be posted on a file transfer program (FTP) and offerors will be provided the web site and password for downloading of the documents. The

solicitation will not be provided to subcontractors, suppliers, or vendors.

**Contracting Procedures:** The solicitation will be a request for proposal (RFP). Source selection will be made using the best value trade-off process. Both non-pricing (technical) and price proposals are required. The evaluation factors with their significance and weight will be provided in the RFP. The Government may include options in the solicitation. The contract will be awarded on a firm-fixed price basis.

**Acquisition Time Line:** Tentative date for issuance of Request for Proposal (RFP) number W912ER-09-R-0068 is 24 Jul 2009. Tentative date for receipt of proposals is 24 Aug 2009. A pre proposal conference/site visit is tentatively scheduled for 03 Aug 2009. Tentative date to award the contract is 30 Sep 2009.
