

ANNOUNCEMENT

SUBJECT: Rotary Wing Parking Apron, Shindand, Afghanistan

NAICS Code: 236220

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineer (USACE) Middle East District intends to solicit names of construction firms or joint ventures experienced in working in the Middle East region who are interested in submitting a firm-fixed price offer for this project. To be considered a construction firm, the firm must perform construction as a significant portion of its business. Defense Base Act Insurance and Construction surety will be required. The estimated cost of the design/build construction is between \$25,000,000 to \$50,000,000.

PROJECT SCOPE: The United States Army Corps of Engineers has the requirement to Construct Rotary Wing Parking Apron at Shindand, Afghanistan. Project includes lighting, markings, tiedown and grounding points, with adequate space for 41 cargo, attack and MEDEVAC helicopter parking and support equipment. Supporting facilities include electric service, water, sewer, gas, paving, walks, curbs and gutters, storm drainage, site improvements and information systems. Antiterrorism/Force Protection measures will be included. All work identified in the Scope of Work shall be completed within 365 days from the Notice to Proceed. Information on a site visit and instructions to obtain access to the site will be provided in the solicitation.

PROPOSAL PROCEDURES: The Request for Proposal (RFP) will only be issued to prime construction contractors. Copies will not be released to suppliers, subcontractors, or plan rooms. Lowest Price Technically Acceptable (LPTA) contracting method will be used to evaluate proposals. Evaluation criteria will be stated in the RFP. The Government may include options in the solicitation. This acquisition will result in a single fixed price construction contract awarded based on LPTA determination.

PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS: This is an electronically issued solicitation. The Government will post the RFP to a file transfer protocol (ftp) site and be pass word protected. Proposals will be received in hard/paper copies only. Electronic and fax proposals will not be accepted.

PROPOSAL PERIOD: The solicitation is scheduled for release on or about 15 July 2010. The proposals will be due on or about 17 August 2010. Contract award will be on or about 28 September 2010.
