QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Q1. In Corridors, Storage Room, Elec/Comm Rooms, is there any Split AC needed or not?

A1. A/C IS REQUIRED FOR COMM ROOM. FOR ALL OTHER AREAS, CONTRACTOR MUST DECIDE PER DESIGN REQUIREMENTS OF RFP SECTION 01015. CONTRACTOR TO DECIDE HOW MANY SPLIT UNITS ARE NEEDED.

Q2. In Showers and toilets any split AC needed or not? Or may be we will install electrical oil heater for winters.

A2. RFP SECTION 01015 CLEARLY STATES THAT SPLIT UNITS ARE NEEDED FOR TOILET-SHOWER AREAS.

Q3. How many persons will be there in each room in the billeting building? Twin bed can be understood as Bunk bed?

A3. RFP INDICATES 14 LIVING SPACES PER FLOOR X 2 FLOORS. THIS EQUATES TO 28 LIVING SPACES OR 28 PERSONNEL. NO BUNK BEDS ARE REQUIRED IN THIS CONTRACT.

Q4. How many persons will be there in the office building? Can the capacity of office building be calculated based on the furniture shown on the drawings provided with the SOW?

A4. LOOK AT FURNITURE PLAN WE PROVIDED. ALSO, WE GAVE YOU APPROX BLDG DIMENSIONS IN RFP - CONTRACTOR DECIDES HOW TO LAYOUT OFFICE SPACE- OUR DWG IS ONLY A GUIDELINE - THIS IS A DESIGN-BUILD CONTRACT SO RESPONSIBILITY IS THE CONTRACTOR - ADDITIONALLY, WE GIVE REFERENCES FOR DESIGN STANDARDS FOR DOD FACILITIES, READ THESE REFERENCES.

Q5. Section 01010 # 4.1 says "Floors in all wet rooms shall have tile and slope (1.5 -2.0 degrees) toward floor drain. Provide concrete stoop with boot scraper at all exterior door entrance" Can we use the fiberglass floors in toilets and shower rooms as this is the best used method for floors in containerized buildings?

A5. RFP SECTION 01015 CLEARLY STATES FLOORS TO BE TERRAZZO.

Q6. The water heaters needed for both the buildings should be fuel operated or electrical?

A6. RFP SECTION 01015, PARAGRAPH 7.3.5 CLEARLY STATES ELECTRICAL.

Q7. What is the area or are the dimensions of the parking place?

A7. UP TO CONTRACTOR TO DECIDE - GENERALLY, STANDARD IS 2500 MM X 5000 MM BUT CONTRACTOR DECIDES BASED UPON DESIGN REFERENCES.

Q8. What is the total length of the access roads which needs to be provided for the office building?

A8. SITE IS SHOWN IN DRAWINGS. CONTRACTOR MUST DECIDE WHAT LENGTH OF ACCESS ROADS TO MEET OUR REQUIREMENTS.

Q9. USACE Office shall include 2 intermediate sidewalks that will tie the paved parking area to the perimeter sidewalk of the USACE office. What is the length of these walkways?

A9. AGAIN, UP TO CONTRACTOR TO DECIDE HOW LONG SIDEWALKS ARE - YOU KNOW THE PURPOSE OF SIDEWALKS, UP TO YOU TO LAYOUT SIDEWALKS TO MEET THIS PURPOSE.

Q10. Section 4.4 says "Contractor shall provide 90cm (36 inch) concrete sidewalk all around each building." Further in the same paragraph its mentioned that "Minimum sidewalk width shall be 1.2 meters" Which is correct?

A10. 900 MM IS AROUND BLDD CONCRETE AREA WHICH IS DIFFERENT FROM THE 1200 MM PEDESTRIAN SIDEWALKS CONNECTING BLDG WITH PARKING LOT.

Q11. How many Hesco's needs to be removed from the site? What is the type of the Hesco's?

A11. VERIFY DURING SITE VISIT.

Q12. What are the dimensions of the paved area which has to be provided on the backside of the office building?

A12. WE GAVE YOU AN APPROXIMATE DWG THAT MEETS USACE NEEDS - CONTRACTOR MUST DECIDE THE EXACT DIMENSIONS TO MEET OUR REQUIREMENTS.

Q13. US WASHERS AND DRYERS – What is the preferred Capacity of these Washers?

A13. WE SAID STANDARD US WASHERS AND DRYERS - GO TO THE INTERNET AND LOOK THIS UP TO VERIFY. THIS IS WHAT ALL OTHER BIDDERS ARE DOING.

Q14. What is the Service Cable Distance And Location From Source To Building / Direction / Provide Layout Plan For Cable Calculations?

A14. CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR CONNECTIONS TO EXISTING UTILITIES. VERIFY DURING SITE VISIT.

Q15. Can Schrack Fire Alarm Systems be used? (NATO APPROVED)

A15. WE DO NOT APPROVE OR DISAPPROVE FIRE ALARM SYSTEMS - WE GAVE YOU TWO STANDARDS, IBC AND NFPA - IF YOU WANT TO USE SCHRACK FIRE ALARM SYSTEMS, INSURE THEY MEET THE IBC AND NFPA - YOU HAVE TO RESEARCH THIS, NOT USACE.

Q16. Can SCHNIEDER Panel Boards be used?

A16. SAME RESPONSE AS # 15

Q17. Can PPR pipes be used instead of PPR pipes?

A17. READ THE RFP TECHNICAL REQUIREMENT SECTION 01015.

Q18. How many B huts are to be demolished? They are not shown on the plan or the drawings, please provide more information.

A18. They are not shown on the plan or the drawings, please provide more information. SEE RFP SECTION 01010, PARAGRAPH 3.8.

Q19. The Price Schedule ITEM NO 0008 says “ Construction- All buildings other than those required for site security and Utilities” Which buildings are included in this Item No. please advise.

A19. THE BUILDINGS ARE LISTIED IN BID SCHEDULE UNDER ITEM 0008.

Q20. Can we use the containers for the enclosure for water tank and staircase instead of CMU?

A20. NO. READ 3.8 OF 01015 - WE CLEARLY STATE CMU WALLS, ALSO, 01010 STATES CMU WALLS REQUIRED FOR STAIRS FIRE PROTECTION.

Q21. Can a site visit be conducted ?
