Memorandum for File: W917PM-07-R-0081 Pre-Solicitation Meeting

A pre-solicitation meeting was held on 7 July 2007 at USACE headquarters in Kabul. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss with potential Offerors the technical and proposal requirements for the solicitation. A list of company attendees is attached.

James Sinclair Contracting Officer

James Sinclair discussed the proposal requirements covering the following points:

1. A summary of the work required to upgrade the ANA Brigade buildings at Pol-Charki and Darulaman. The work entails installation of diesel fired heating unit, evaporative cooling units, ductwork, building and roof insulation, and underground water and fuel pipes.
2. Sections 00100 and 00110 of the RFP were reviewed citing the points:
  - A. One original and three copies of the proposal are to be provided by each offeror.
  - B. Volumes I and II must be separated but can be packaged together.
  - C. Each offeror must have a DUNS number. Instructions on how to receive one are furnished in section 00100 of the RFP.
  - D. Security and DBS Insurance costs must be spread over the CLINS of the proposal.
  - E. Section 00100, page 11 details the "Minimum Content" for an Offeror's proposal.
3. Section 00120 describing the method of evaluation and award of Lowest Price Technically acceptable was described.

Thomas Berry gave a brief description of the technical requirements for the work. The floor was opened for questions. One company representative inquired if the equipment must be from a particular manufacturer. Ken Hiratsuka answered that there are a number of manufacturers that can supply the equipment and USACE is not limiting the selection. However, the equipment must all be provided from one manufacturer. No further questions were asked so the meeting was adjourned.
