The US Army Corps of Engineers, Afghanistan Engineer District intends to issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) to award one Firm-Fixed-Price contracts for design and construction of one range complex with 8 new ranges, and related roads and support facilities for the Afghanistan National Army at Camp Shaheen MeS, Afghanistan. The awards for this procurement shall be made in accordance with the applicable federal acquisition regulations. The NAICS code for this work is 236220. One contract shall be awarded. The total contract value shall be \$5,000,000.00 to \$10,000,000.00. The options may be exercised at the discretion of the Government for terms described. The Government shall award a single contract resulting from this solicitation to the responsible offeror whose offer conforms to the solicitation requirements and will provide the lowest priced- technically acceptable proposal to the Government (considering technical and price factors). The Government reserves the right to award the contracts to other than the lowest priced offeror. Solicitation Number W917PM-09-R-0007 will be available on or about 15 October 2008.
