

## Synopsis

### Design & Construct ANA Troop Medical Clinic Herat, Afghanistan

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineer, Afghanistan District intends to issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) to award one Firm Fixed Price contract, Full & Open for the design & construction of a Troop Medical Clinic (TMC) for the Afghanistan National Army located in Herat, Afghanistan.

The award for this procurement shall be made in accordance with applicable federal acquisition regulations and the NAICS code for this work is 236220. One firm fixed priced contract shall be awarded and the magnitude of this requirement is between \$1,000,000.00 and \$5,000,000.00. Options may or may not be exercised at the time of award and will be at the discretion of the Government. The Government shall award a single contract resulting from this solicitation to the responsible offeror whose offer conforms to the solicitation requirements and will provide the lowest priced-technically acceptable proposal to the Government (considering technical and price factors).
