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Corps of Engineers awards \$11M in contracts for Afghanistan National Army

KABUL - The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers awarded two contracts totaling more than \$11 million for the construction of two border police company headquarter stations for the Afghanistan National Army in the Faryab Province of Afghanistan, Feb. 28.

Faryab Province is located in the northwest portion of Afghanistan near the Afghanistan-Turkmenistan border.

The construction of border police company headquarters in the villages of Yaka Haji and Yaka Toot will both feature barracks, an administrative building, bathrooms and showers, laundry facilities, a warehouse, a dining facility, a gate house, a guard shack, guard towers and a fuel & generator canopy.

Contracting company State Corps Ltd. was awarded the \$5.4 million contract to build Yaka Toot company headquarters while Omran Holding Group was awarded the \$5.6 million contract to build Yaka Haji company headquarters. Both companies are located in Kabul.

Construction is scheduled to be complete in one year for both projects.

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
