U.S. Army Corps of Engineers celebrates completion of Afghanistan police battalion headquarters

KABUL - The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers completed a \$13.7 million Afghan National Civil Order Police battalion headquarters facility in the Zurmat District of Paktiya, Afghanistan, March 17.

Paktiya is located in the southeast portion of northern Afghanistan near the Pakistan border.

The headquarters facility will provide an operating and living base for 412 police officers and includes barracks, a dining facility, laundry facilities, a warehouse, vehicle maintenance facility, an ammunition supply point and logistical support system.

Proccea Construction Co., based out of Ankara, Turkey was the contractor on the project. At the height of construction, 330 Afghans were employed.
