District builds on September success in October

KANDAHAR AIRFIELD, Afghanistan— The Afghanistan Engineer District-South continued the strong pace it set in the last month of FY 11 with another excellent performance in the first month of FY 12.

The district placed \$61.8 million in construction in October, surpassing the mark of \$54 million in placement in September. Construction placement is a measure of the progress contractors are making toward completing projects.


Project completions and turn-overs also maintained momentum. Here are the projects the district completed and turned over to customers in October.

- Afghan Uniform Police District Headquarters in Shindand, Herat province—a \$1.4 million project begun in March 2010, finished Oct. 1, 2011.
- Electrical distribution system, Afghan National Army Camp Hero, Kandahar province—a \$1.2 million project begun in August 2010, finished Sep. 31, 2011.
- Fuel spill containment structure, Camp Zafar/Shindand Airfield, Herat province—a \$320,000 project, begun in March 2011, finished Oct. 9, 2011.
- Afghan National Border Police Company Headquarters at Mohammed Sayar, Spin Boldak district, Kandahar province—a \$5.6 million project, begun in June 2008, finished Oct. 27, 2011.

- Highway 4, Tarnak Bridge bypass, Kandahar province—a \$911,000 project, begun in Sep. 2010, finished Oct. 6, 2011.



- Afghan National Army fuel depot, Camp Hero, Kandahar province—an \$883,000 project, begun in June 2010, finished Oct. 31, 2011.
